- WED. 1.—Applications for nomination to Commissions in the British Army, and to Military Cadetships.

- MON. 20.—Last day of Entry for Examinations for Final Honours, Scholarships and Higher Degrees.
- MON. 27.—Examination for Exhibitions in Music at the Conservatorium.
